Luke 4:18 Jesus says:

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised.

- 1. To point the poor and needy to their true source of "life more abundant and free"* in Christ Jesus.
- 2. To promote healing of the broken hearted... prescribe deliverance to those who are in bondage...offer guidance in gaining insight to the spiritually blind... proclaim the truth that sets at liberty those who are bruised."
- 3. To promote healing of the broken hearted through Christian Counseling, Theophostic prayer and Temperament education and application through written materials, electronic and social media, skits and screen plays, lectures and seminars.
- 4. To prescribe deliverance to those who are in bondage by vanquishing the lies we have come to believe and the father of lies who brought them.
- To offer guidance through Life Lessons, consisting of daily spiritual exercises, insights and strategies to
 overcome difficulties in life, enlightening eyes to spiritual maturity by understanding ones own God given
 temperament.
- 6. To proclaim the freedom of truth to those whose lives are battered and bruised and broken in sin by introducing them to the one who is the source of all Truth to show them the Way and give them the Life in Jesus Christ.
- 7. Plan and hold prevention seminars for groups, families, and couples, to disseminate information that will help to thwart dysfunctional experiences in their lives. For instance, couples can attend "prevention parenting" sessions that will help them to control their children and enhance their parent/child relationships (II Timothy 4:1-2).
- 8. Enlighten all troubled people who will accept the invitation of God's love in all areas of need about, (a) who God is, (b) what He requires of us, and (c) the saving and healing grace of Jesus Christ and how they can find peace in Him. This is to be accomplished by speaking to persons, at church meetings, church group sessions, youth group sessions, men and women's conferences, Christian schools and other organizations. Presentations will be enhanced by the use of electronic media, printed material, power point presentations, testimonies of those who have experienced the benefits of new life in Christ through counseling, and Bible study (Acts 5:20; Il Timothy 4:2; Titus 2; Isaiah 62:6; Acts 1:8).

	She puts drug recovery at the head of the list of needs, but also suggests it is the least likely to succeed. There is an epidemic of apathy and 'hard core' users who have no personal motivation to change. They have grown comfortable in their pain and though counseling is available to themthey do not access it. The big hindrances given by most people for failure or problems are: Transportation, jobs, and housing. She says that though transportation, communications, educations and other accommodations have been made to assist people to overcome their problemsthey do not respond. They even expect the workers to complete their paper work for them. She sees it as almost hopeless at this point. Family and parenting skills or counseling are next on the list. She suggests that aid and counseling for GRANDPARENTS might be a best investment, due to the numbers of grandparents rearing grandchildren. They seem to have a better work ethic, she says. Next she suggested that marriage counseling is probably less desired than 'relationship counseling' given the diverse 'family' makeup. Mentoring is a good model for helping people overcome long term, but finding local mentors who will stay committed or even volunteer has been a huge hurdle for their programs.

He is active in community development and volunteers with the local youth league sports and recreational activities. He is a regular member of the Baptist Church. His concerns were for the community's youth. He sees a dismal future if no jobs are introduced to the area. The dilemma is that factory type jobs will not come to with a drug culture so entrenched. Discipline and dependability are marginal and a work force is not sufficient to sustain typical factory needs. He is exploring alternative job creation for the area. Drug recovery and support for those who are addicted, but recovering, would be a very welcome asset to the overall effort to reform the community. He sees an incremental approach to rebuilding the community as the one with most potential. Small grants are his focus for now as the town's image and reputation are being restored.
